INTRODUCTION

SACRIFICIAL LOVE

I knew a missionary in the Arctic Circle. One frigid winter night, he shared about Jesus with a man in an igloo. When the man abruptly left, the missionary sensed the Holy Spirit wanted him to continue talking, so he followed him with only a tee shirt. He was only outside in sub-zero air for five minutes, but this sacrificial gesture cost him dearly. He permanently lost partial use of one of his lungs. When I spoke with him about the event, he had no regrets for obeying the Holy Spirit. He was convinced the man's life was worth whatever sacrifice he made. I still can't think about what this brave man did without being challenged.

Much of the Church sits in an igloo, warm, cozy, safe, and comfortable, while our culture—our children, naively drift further into the frozen unreality of deception. It was where I spent my youth and five years at a university. I was an atheist, hating God, mocking the Bible and Christians while aggressively advocating the lies presented on the "UNREALITY" pages of this Book.

After a broken relationship and two abortions, I spent six months contemplating suicide every day. Desperate, I tried to cut my wrists and cried out to the God I didn't believe in. Within six months, the jaws of death and Hell had just about consumed me when I surrendered my life to Jesus and was delivered from demons. My mother's prayers and the grace of God rescued me on Mother's Day, 1972. Since then, I have been a whole-hearted follower of Jesus.

Creation Begins

NO CREATOR = NO FUTURE

If there is no Creator, then we have no destiny, no future—just wishful thinking. Everything is mere mythology based on fiction and not fact. If we evolved as a cosmic coincidence from blobs, slime, or frogs, then we have no ultimate purpose or eternal value. None of us have a future of any consequence outside of God; man's ego does not give him a future. "God's will alone" provides us with a future. Only because there is a loving God who created us with a purpose do we have a destiny and something to look forward to. Thank God we each have a magnificent script written before the foundation of the world. Ask God daily to show you His plan for your life... because He will!

We cannot create better than God. We can only misread and deform. When I give up too soon on God's plan, no other imagined intent can satisfy who I am created to be. It is a tragic misunderstanding. Believe God's Word more than the world's warped values, and you will experience the miracle behind the mystery of your life.

MARRIAGE PROTECTS WOMEN

Contrary to conventional wisdom, one of the most significant benefits to women is a God-ordained institution called marriage. It can protect a woman from being taken advantage of by a man who wants the benefits of a relationship without the responsibility. In its "Universal Declaration of Human Rights," even the United Nations declared rightly, "the Family is the natural and fundamental group unit of society..." The only challenge to this sentence comes when we are deceived into thinking we can redefine a family. God defined marriage and family for all generations: "...a man shall leave his father and his mother and hold fast to his wife, and they shall become one flesh." (Genesis 2:24, ESV) May we each find the protection we long for by aligning ourselves with God's inspired order.

We can't create life. We can't even redefine it without deforming it. At best, we'll create a horror of what God intended. We live in a world where deformity is being called normal. The truth is only what God intended is normal. What man's imagination produces is often a mangled misrepresentation. You can redefine your gender and sexual identity, but from God's point of view, you're not a mistake. You are fearfully and wonderfully made in the image and likeness of a loving Creator. Man playing God always ends badly. It's a shortlived mistake fueled by pride and a rejection of reality. None of us are everything we want to be, but we are given all that we need to live a healthy life and become like God, as He intended. (1 Peter 1:3)

WHY OSTRICHES **BURY THEIR HEADS**

Why do ostriches bury their head in the sand? Is it because they are trying to hide and run away from a fight? Hardly! It is because they are turning their eggs. They are taking care of their family. They are nurturing the next generation. In this "most distracted age," we should always feel we are spending our time wisely, being present, and caring for our children.

REALITY / UNREALITY


Would you believe we sometimes need to do the ridiculous to experience the miraculous? Noah built an ark in preparation for a flood, even though it had never rained.

False Faces of Religion

RELIGION VS. RELATIONSHIP

One of the greatest dangers of following religious rituals is that they temporarily soothe our conscience without requiring us to obey God's Spirit. This was one of the favorite practices of Pharisees during the time of Jesus. After Judas betrayed Jesus and then killed himself, religious leaders decided it was unlawful for them to take the money that Judas had thrown down. They reasoned that because he was a murderer, they couldn't put the money back into the temple treasury. What could be more absurd than that? They had paid Judas to betray Jesus, the Savior of the world. They now felt it was immoral to put their blood money back into their treasury—a perfect example of the difference between religious ritual and the redemptive reality of a genuine relationship with God.

Religion provides a false comfort, a conscience-soothing relief from the pressures of life. At the same time, a fully surrendered relationship with Jesus Christ heals the heart, transforms the mind, enlightens the Spirit, and establishes the union with God that He created us to have. Refrain from settling for a repetitive ritual that leads to numbness. Pursue an unpredictable intimacy with the God Who alone can provide the fulfillment we long for.

PHARISEES

I cannot present my life to fellow believers as more whole than I am. This would make me no better than the Pharisees of old. My only honest option is to acknowledge the obvious: I am a flawed man desperately in need of a gracious Savior to rescue me and an all-wise Lord to rule over my soul and spirit. For this to happen, I must turn myself in daily, living a transparent life that embarrasses and costs me the most.

1 CORINTHIANS 2:14

Miracles today are considered far-fetched, beyond belief, and unscientific. Science is God. The Bible is for the weak and simple-minded. But the Bible says, "Someone living on an entirely human level rejects the revelations of God's Spirit, for they make no sense to him... they are only discovered by the illumination of the Spirit."

John the Baptist defined what true success is when he said, "He must become greater and greater, and I must become less and less." (John 3:30, NLT) Exalting self is always unhealthy. We are created to lift up Jesus. Nothing else can fully satisfy.



Jesus said, "I tell you the truth, of all who have ever lived, none is greater than John the Baptist. Yet even the least person in the Kingdom of Heaven is greater than he is!" Wow! Think of it: the seemingly least significant Christian, weak in faith, struggling with victory, and feeling like they barely made it into Heaven, is infinitely more blessed than any spiritual giant who ever walked the Earth before Jesus.



John the Baptist was asked by Jewish leaders who he was and then flattered him with heady options: the Christ, Elijah, and the Prophet. Yet John didn't take the bait but humbly responded, "I'm (just a) voice crying out in the wilderness." (John 1:23). Even Jesus refused to succumb to Pilate, wanting Him to boast about who He was. Proverbs affirms, "Let another praise you, and not your own mouth; someone else, and not your own lips." (Proverbs 27:2). If anyone could grandstand, it would be God. And yet, He chose to come to Earth as a humble servant, lived entirely under the radar, and ended His Earthly script, dying a humiliating, agonizing death. So, when someone offers you the bait of false praise, go low. If you do, you'll meet Jesus there as a victim. Let Jesus make you the victor He created you to be.

Jesus Is The Only Way


OSWALD CHAMBERS

Let Jesus make you the victor He created you to be.

The greatest failures in my life occurred when I believed lies about what is most true about me. The fact is: we are all living in various stages of repentance. We are either acknowledging or denying when we fail, and then repenting of our sins, or going our merry way as if nothing happened. But something has happened. We have all sinned and fallen short of God's best for us. Yet, if that's all we know, we're missing the best part of the story, that what is most true about me is not just what God is focusing on, but what He wants me to focus on as well. Don't fixate on what you're not, when God's centering in on what you are: created to be sons and daughters of the living God.

BEING SINCERE IS NOT ENOUGH

Job's friends thought he must have done bad things to be suffering the way he did, but that's not what God thought. This line of thinking is closer to "Hinduism" and "Buddhism," not "Christianity." In the Buddhist and Hindu religions, "Karma" is considered "the force produced by a person's actions in one life that influences what happens to them in future lives." The Bible demolishes the false concept of reincarnation when it says, "... it is appointed for man to die once, and after that comes judgment..." (Hebrews 9:27, ESV). Jesus didn't come to Earth to judge or condemn us; He came to rescue us from the consequences of our own poor decisions.

COMPARATIVE RELIGIONS

Like Satan, they offer a broad way that only leads to destruction. "...your adversary, the devil, walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour." Wells without water and clouds without rain, they remind me of... me.

WHO WOULD NEVER COME TO JESUS

Do you ever wonder if any of the lawless anarchists will ever come to Jesus? I do. I think back to my rebellion against authority. A girl I was living with had a father who was a New York City firefighter. He would only allow me in his home once I cut my hair. In a gesture of defiance, I cut my long hair off, put it in a bag, and walked into his home during breakfast, plopping the bag in front of him. I then abruptly walked out and never saw him again. A few years later, after becoming a follower of Jesus, I began to contact people I had hurt. Calling him, I humbly asked for his forgiveness. Much to my surprise, He graciously forgave me. 
Truth Alone Brings Freedom

(Proverbs 4:18, NKJV) Do not let the good intentions of deceived people poison your life. Look to Jesus and be saved!

HOT TUBS & ICE CREAM

Nowhere is the cultural malaise more apparent than in the increasingly prolonged adolescence of the average American. A half-century of children has grown up with pleasure at their fingertips. The comforts of life do not create growth. No one has ever been transformed sitting in a hot tub eating Ben & Jerry's.

REALITY / UNREALITY

The root cause of this global malaise can be easily isolated: It results from wanting things our way. It always leads to frustration and confusion. These are the bitter fruits of being disconnected from our Creator, the source of life, liberty, and true happiness.

COUNTERFEIT REALITY

Only God can design from emptiness. Truth and reality stand resolute whether we believe in them or not. As Paul. the great teacher, once wrote, "For we can do nothing against the truth, but for the truth." (2 Corinthians 13:8, NKJV) We cannot create reality — only deception. So, too, with the devil! He is the Creator of nothing eternal and the counterfeiter of everything pure and holy.

Only "God's Truth" Transforms

AVALANCHE OF DECEPTION

As an avalanche of deception attempts to redefine truth, lies, good, and evil, so is there an assault against genuine love and the relational order God intended. The truth will eventually prevail. However, the interim misrepresentation of the virtue of God's love will separate what is eternally true from what is a distortion and a lie. "But those who obey God's Word truly show how completely they love Him. That is how we know we are living in Him." (1 John 2:5)

REALITY / UNREALITY

Those who attempt to redefine compassion as "embracing every person's belief with love and understanding" will find that reality is not malleable. We cannot conform truth to our image. In the end, we will be conformed to the truth. God will either be a stepping-stone guiding us to His only reality or, if we choose to cling to our deception, an eternal stumbling block to fantasy.

FREEDOM AND TRUTH

There's no shortage of people talking about freedom and truth. But may we always remember what freedom and truth are and where they come from. Freedom and truth come from God alone. Worldly seductions bring a temporary sense of freedom that always leads to bondage and depression. Man's attempts to redefine and repackage truth only result in deception and lies. The truth that transforms requires the compassionate courage to believe and do what God intended would set us free. Jesus said to the people who believed in Him, "You are truly My disciples if you remain faithful to My teachings. And you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." (John 8:31-32, NLT) Accept no earthly substitutes for truth and freedom. They are only real if they are Heaven-sent!

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Like many of today's educators, "Claiming to be wise, they instead became utter fools." (Romans 1:22). Even King Solomon, the wisest man who ever lived, fell into complete deception. "For it was so, when Solomon was old, that his wives turned his heart after other gods; and his heart was not loyal to the LORD his God, as was the heart of his father, David." (1 Kings 11:4)

Education's Demise

CULTURAL CLONES & MORAL ZOMBIES

The world is loaded with opinions. Social media showcases the bravado of man, each claiming to have the higher thought, the deeper insight, the better way. Anyone can take the stage, grab a mic, and bellow their truth. "Believe this! Do this!" The Bible clears the air when it says, "Be free from pridefilled opinions, for they will only harm your cherished unity." (Philippians 2:3, TPT) Much of what people call deep-seated convictions are merely shallow whims. More often than not, they follow the clueless crowd, turning naive minions into cultural clones, moral zombies, and wells without water. Everything in Heaven and Earth will pass away, but only God's Word and His truth will last forever. Jesus and His Word are the only ones left standing. Let your convictions be grounded in eternal realities, not earthly fantasies.

REALITY / UNREALITY

EDUCATION'S HYPOCRISY

Noah Webster defined hypocrisy as "a simulation; a feigning to be what one is not; a concealment of one's real character or motives... assuming of a false appearance of virtue..." (Noah Webster's 1828 American Dictionary) Hypocrisy is a simulation, a fake, a sham, concealing the real person. It refers to someone who professes a conviction but lives a double life. Hypocrisy is the one sin Jesus most aggressively exposed.

Suicide's Seduction

IS DEPRESSION A DISEASE?

Recently, I read that a notable person's daughter had died of a disease. Upon further examination of the facts, the article said she died from a disease called "depression." I've battled with depression my entire adult life. I spent six months before I gave my heart to Jesus contemplating suicide every day. Since then, I've learned that being free from depression is possible and often a daily choice. Though living in victory is a struggle, I needed to believe that my depression was not entirely out of my control. Jesus confirmed this when he said, "Don't let your hearts be troubled." (John 14:1, NLT) The devil's great lie is that suicide is a valid choice to end our depression. It is the most grotesque lie of all. Depression doesn't have to be a life sentence. There's always hope and help in Jesus.



SUICIDE RISING

In 2021, suicide was the second leading cause of death for people ages 10-14 and 20-34. Eighty percent of all deaths by suicide in the U.S. are among men and women aged 45-54. Men aged 85 and older have the highest suicide rate of any group in the country. (April 24, 2023)

REALITY / UNREALITY

God has never lost hope for our future. And only He knows the tests we must face to live fulfilled lives. Don't be surprised if the season you are closest to walking in your destiny is simultaneously the lowest point in your life. We have to get creamed before we can get crowned. The Bible says, "...since we are His children, we are His heirs, together with Christ, we are heirs of God's glory. But if we are to share His glory, we must also share His suffering..." (2 Timothy 2:12) We'll lose hope for our future when we lose hope in God.

PSALM 34:17-20

"The Lord hears his people when they call to him for help. He rescues them from all their troubles. The Lord is close to the brokenhearted; he rescues those whose spirits are crushed. The righteous person faces many troubles, but the Lord comes to the rescue each time."

The Spirit of God said of King David, "I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after My heart, who will do all My will." (Acts 13:22)

MICRO-OBEDIENCE

I've often wondered what elevated spiritual giants. I believe it was their micro-obedience: Doing the will of God as He asked them to, not merely what was convenient. It's the difference between doing the Word of God or just hearing it.

LIFE IS A TEST

Accept nothing at face value. "...for we walk by faith, not by sight." (2 Corinthians 5:7, ESV) I'm not moved by what I see. I want to allow the inner witness of God's Spirit to guide me. Every decision we make tests our motives, and in the end we will be judged by the thoughts and intents of our heart. The Bible says, "But I, the LORD, search all hearts and examine secret motives. It's sad and pathetic. You've been so faithful to me."

HEALING OR OFFENSE

AND REPORT OF THE PARTY.

When people hurt us, we always have a choice. Either we seek the healing God alone can give or wallow in the pain of past offenses. No one escapes the planet unhurt. It's the price of admission to the human race: a marathon not for the faint-hearted or fault-finding but for the faithful few humbled by their own shortcomings rather than the faults of others.



If you want to be healed, you'll need to walk in the light of God's love, forgiveness, comfort, and power. God's love covers, His grace forgives, and His Spirit comforts and empowers us to be fully healed: spirit, soul, and body. Time doesn't heal, Jesus does. Look to Him first in the challenges of life. He'll never disappoint you.

THE FORGIVEN HEART

It's been said, "There is no revenge so sweet as forgiveness." (American Humorist, Josh Billings) Our forgiving others opens the door for God to forgive us. The hardness in our heart shuts God out. If we have hard, unforgiving hearts, it calls into question if we have ever received or appreciated God's forgiveness. The forgiven heart longs to forgive others. The forgiven heart relinquishes its right to punish others. The forgiven heart will no longer hold that person responsible for what they did. Jesus said, "...when you are praying, first forgive anyone you are holding a grudge against, so that your Father in heaven will forgive your sins, too." (Mark 11:25) "Jesus, I forgive those who have hurt me. I release them from all responsibility. Even now I fully receive your forgiveness for me."

FREEDOM FROM GUILT

While God's forgiveness completely covers and washes away my past sins and every dimension of guilt and shame for my foolishness, past regretful memories, and an active conscience keep me vigilant in not making choices that would destroy my present life. Moments of pleasure have, at times, left me with a lifetime of regret. The Psalmist understood this all too well when he wrote, "Keep your servant from deliberate sins! Don't let them control me. Then I will be free of guilt and innocent of great sin." (Psalm 19:13, NLT) As Heaven and Hell motivate and inspire me, so do right and wrong. Therefore, my daily prayer is, "God, keep me from making foolish decisions that may feel good for a moment but bring consequences I will greatly regret."

That's quite a demonstrative sentence and shouldn't be sweepingly applied. But He wasn't overstating it! We can't live with one foot in the Word and the other in the world. Eventually, we will be drawn away from the truth to believe lies. Sadly, I've seen it all too often. What started as a flirtation with sin led to bondage and addiction. "Above all else, guard your heart, for it is the wellspring of life." (Proverbs 4:23, NIV)

Do you have secrets? We all do, and we all do our best to keep our secrets from certain people who would use them to hurt us. There is, however, one Person who knows all of our secrets and wants to help us. Do we believe we can hide them from Him without consequence?

SECRETS EXPOSED

The thought of our secrets eventually being exposed is intended to put the fear of God in us. And what would be the value of that? God's Word is clear: so that we may depart from evil and cling to what is good, our lives will be blessed. It sounds like me knowing God will judge my secrets is designed to be a good thing.







Turn Yourself In

TITUS 1:15, ESV

If we wait to get caught instead of turning ourselves in, our conscience will become corrupted and polluted. Scripture confirms this. "Everything is pure to those whose hearts are pure. But nothing is pure to those who are corrupt and unbelieving, because their minds and consciences are corrupted." (Titus 1:15, ESV)

JAMES 4:6, ESV

When it comes to sin, we can wait to get caught or turn ourselves in. The former resists connection to God. The latter opens up an intimate relationship with our Creator that unlocks the essence of our very existence. If, as the Bible states, "God opposes the proud, but gives grace to the humble," then humility is key to experiencing God's transforming power. (James 4:6, ESV)

Rick Warren says it this way. "Humility is not thinking less of yourself; it's thinking of yourself less." Legendary UCLA basketball coach John Wooden said, "There is no pillow as soft as a clear conscience." The opposite is also true. Who can rest when your mind is being smothered with guilt? We will find no peace in life without a peace-filled conscience! And there's only one way to get it. Turn yourself in! Admit to a holy God that you have sinned. He is always ready to forgive; His blood will cover any sin. Jesus died for us to give us a clear conscience. May we take these words to heart: "Conscience is God's built-in warning system. Be very happy when it hurts. Be very worried when it doesn't."

MY PRAYER

"Lord! I want my hope to be in You alone. The disappointment I feel sometimes comes from not receiving what I was hoping for instead of trusting that You are already committed to giving me what is best for me, and only You know what that is."

REALITY / UNREALITY

One day, I thought, "There is so much prayer going up by the saints that God would certainly answer them in the affirmative." I was wrong. In retrospect, some of my prayers have, in essence, been, "Lord, I can see clearly what needs to happen. So, I thank you for answering my prayers." Now, I see that much of my disappointment in life comes from me playing God and asking Him to merely sign off on what I consider to be best. In the end, it's called my will, not God's.

DEBILITATING EXPECTATIONS

Expectations are a funny thing. We can't live without them; eventually, we realize we can't live with them. They're fun when they're met, debilitating when they're not, and frankly, unless they're God's expectations for us, they may be precisely what we don't need. I can't meet your expectations of me, and you can't meet mine for you. But perhaps the worst thing about expectations is believing that we haven't met God's expectations or that He hasn't met ours. But the truth is, God's relationship with us is NOT based on "expectations" but on "acceptance." God loves who He created us to be, and the main reason He wants us to change our behavior is that some of our decisions distort who we are designed to be. Accept God's love for you, and your expectation of Him will be filled with trust.

PREFERENCE CHRISTIANITY

Jesus said, "Your will be done, not My will." and "I do nothing, except what I see my Father doing." (John 5:19). Before you can love your life, you have to solve the riddle of life. Paul the Apostle said, "I've learned the secret of being content in every situation." (Philippians 4:11). That's why the greatest hindrances to you loving your life are your Preferences and Expectations. "Preference Christianity" implies that we know what's best for our lives, and "Expectation Christianity" leads to disappointment and discouragement. Both are us playing God. It's what the Pharisees did, and the opposite of what Jesus preached. Man playing God is what Lucifer did. He said, "I will...be like the Most High." (Isaiah 14:14). If you know the future, then preferences and expectations are great. But, frankly, neither you nor anyone else does.

MATTHEW 11:7-8, NLT

Here's one way to eliminate disappointment. Don't presume your expectations are the road to experiencing God's promises. Jesus addressed this issue when He spoke to the crowds about John the Baptist. "What kind of man did you go into the wilderness to see? ...a weak reed, swayed by every breath of wind? ...were you expecting to see a man dressed in expensive clothes? No, people with expensive clothes live in palaces." (Matthew 11:7-8, NLT)

REALITY / UNREALITY

If something DIS-appoints you, perhaps it was an appointment that was not meant to be or not at this time. If, on the other hand, we put God in charge of our schedule and appointments, then when the chess pieces on the board move around, we have little to no emotional attachment to where they land. When our hearts are filled with complete trust in the only Person who knows what's best for us, life becomes a delightful dance, not dreary drudgery.

EXPERIENCING ABUNDANT LIFE

Do you think Jesus overstated His promise when He said, "I have come that they may have life and that they may have it more abundantly."? (John 10:10, NKJV) Regarding how many believers live abundant lives, this scripture is nearly impossible. Yet, Christ's promise is not a pipe dream; it's God's will for each of us. Having lived for over 50 years following Jesus, I am persuaded the abundant life Jesus promised requires three essential transformations in each of our perspectives:

- 1. We must have an accurate understanding of who God is.
- 2. That will bring the greatest clarity on how He views each of us.
- 3. Only then can we love the life He's given us.

God is love. He loves, and even likes, every one of us. And His will is the best of all possible options.

Contentment &

Lasting Peace

Blaming God is one of the greatest misconceptions in life. Contentment means trusting Him no matter what's happening. It's more of a decision than a consequence. It's the opposite of the victim mindset and makes me responsible for my responses to life. Paul wrote, "I've learned in whatever state I am, there I'll be content." (Philippians 4:11)

MEANING OF "SHALOM"

Have you ever heard someone say "Shalom!"? It's a beautiful Hebrew word. I used to think it meant "peace," but it means much more. Shalom speaks to our wholeness, well-being, safety, happiness, completeness, peace, security, prosperity, victory, contentment, and rest.

The Bible says, "Keep turning your back on every sin, and make "peace" / "shalom" your life motto. Practice being at peace with everyone." (Psalm 34:14) Shalom...be whole, completely at peace, restored by the blood of Jesus, and the marvelous grace of God.

BREEDING GROUND FOR PAIN

In our physical bodies, when muscles are stiff and unpliable, they gradually become unusable; it may have started when we got hurt. Damaged tissue restricts blood from flowing to muscles, and when there's no blood flow, we lack oxygen, and our muscles begin to die. Does a bad habit block your life? Often, we become so consumed with our pain that we're unable to focus on anything else. These constricted areas become stagnant ponds, breeding grounds for more pain. What's the cure? Let the life-giving blood of Jesus flow over your battered life, your heart, mind, and emotions, restoring whatever's been damaged.

NUMBING SUBSTITUTES

The devil offers an endless menu of numbing substitutes for oneness with God. Morphine was initially developed as a cough suppressant. Yet, by the late 1800s, it had become a popular recreational drug. A German drug company named Bayer believed it had found a morphine replacement. So, it advertised diacetylmorphine as an over-the-counter "non-addictive morphine substitute." The new product Heroin derived its name from the Greek word "heros" because of its seemingly heroic effects on the user. Unfortunately, if you've ever known a person with a heroin addiction, the last thing they are is heroic. As is always the case, one numb substitute leads to another. Accept no substitutes. Only Jesus can give you the peace you need.

REALITY / UNREALITY

Why are so many people numb today? Numb to life, numb to God, numb to one another? The word numb means "taken or seized as by cold or grief." So, what will it take to propel us from living an emotionless, boring existence? We'd need a fully surrendered heart, a desperate cry to the God of resurrection.

PROVERBS 4:23, NIV

For many of us, survival means letting God warm up the places in our heart that have become numb. One of the most significant warnings in Scripture concerns a cold or dead heart. "Above all else, guard your heart, for it is the wellspring of life." (Proverbs 4:23, NIV)

The peer pressure of the crowd will only increase, as will their rejection of those who follow Jesus and refuse to follow their evil ways. As Jesus promised, "...the person who endures to the end will be saved." (Matthew 24:13)

Do you believe God has a marvelous destiny for you? I'm convinced He does, and it's better than you could ever imagine. Noah Webster's definition of "destiny" is perfect: "...a predetermined state; a condition foreordained by the Divine will." When you look closely, everything about this definition speaks of obedience. Since it takes God to destine, it stands to reason only God can predestine or predetermine and likewise foreordain. The only real destiny is God's will, and the only way you get God's will is by being obedient to Him. The Bible says, "...(God) will do for me all He has planned. He controls my destiny." (Job 23:14, NLT)

WE ARE BEAUTIFUL TO GOD

You are beautiful to God... greatly loved and treasured. Believing this is the doorway to experiencing the greatest joy in life. If we believe as God states. 




When "Hope" Beats "Concern"

OBEDIENCE BRINGS HEALING

All of us will need to be healed at some point in our lives, whether in spirit, soul, or body. One action in the Bible that always precedes healing is obedience. After the children of Israel were delivered from the Egyptians and miraculously passed through the Red Sea, the Lord gave them a promise, "I am the Lord who heals you." The prerequisite for this magnificent statement is found in the previous verse. "If you diligently heed the voice of the Lord your God and do what is right in His sight, give ear to His commandments and keep all His statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you which I brought on the Egyptians." (Exodus 15:26, NKJV) Though we may not see it or understand it, obeying God always brings blessing, healing, and deliverance.

DOCTOR OR PATIENT?

Am I on a journey to become a doctor, or destined to remain a patient? The only person who can make that decision is me. I may be hurt, but I must be more committed to being healed than rehashing my pain. Jesus suffered and died so we could become completely whole inside. Receiving that healing is a life-long process, but worth every minute.

PICK UP YOUR MAT

In John 5, Jesus approached a man who had been unable to walk for 38 years and asked, "Would you like to get well?" It seemed like a silly question, yet it pinpoints the real issue for each of us who need healing. What do we really want? And what are we willing to do to get it? Jesus then gave the man three critical instructions: 'Stand up, pick up your mat, and walk!" (John 5:8, NLT) Three essential prerequisites for any of us to get whole: "Stand up!" Are you willing to move away from where you have been? "Pick up your mat!" Are you committed never to going back? And lastly, "Walk!" Will you do anything necessary to get whole, even if you've never done it?

My daughter, Havilah, offered healing insights as she was preaching. She said something quite profound, "You're not broken! You just don't know who you are!" WOW! The lights came on! What if our mental and emotional health could be best achieved by not fixating on what we're not but on who we are and how God sees us? His view of us is infinitely more important than how we see ourselves.





ELIJAH'S CHALLENGE

Faith always requires passionate action, not passive thinking. No debate, just unquestioning obedience. Often, it seems that when God calls me on Line One, the devil calls me on Line Two to undermine what God asked me to do. Elijah challenged the people, "How long will you waver between two opinions? If the LORD is God, follow him..." (1 Kings 18:21, NIV)

IMAGINARY EVIL OR REAL GOOD

Every day, we fight to hold on to what is real and eternal—not to be deceived by the shallow and temporary. Abandoned by parents, exploited by peers, and seduced by society, many of us are overexposed and underdeveloped. We've seen so much yet become so little! Perhaps the greatest farce of our day is evil masquerading as good. Our age is a fashion show for evil. Simone Weil writes, "Imaginary evil is romantic and varied. Real evil is gloomy, monotonous, barren, boring. Imaginary good is boring. Real good is always new, marvelous, intoxicating." (Weil S. Gravity and Grace. Rutledge; 1999.) Only God is truly good; no one can fill our lives with goodness except God!

Satan's Supernatural Harms

REALITY / UNREALITY

During deceptive seasons, I have empowered thoughts and actions that caused evil to grow in my heart. Eventually, by the grace of God, I realized I needed to become more aware of what I was naively perpetuating. I am not just a seed sower. I am a seed waterer. Jesus said, "Every plant which My heavenly Father did not plant shall be uprooted..." (Matthew 15:13, NIV) If I am not careful, the weeds will overtake the fruit and flowers, choking out what is eternal and precious, leaving only what is temporary and meaningless.

EPHESIANS 6:11-12, ESV

"Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil. For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places."

If we are honest with ourselves, though the devil is called the father of lies (John 8:44), no one has lied to me more than me. Frankly, I'm the biggest liar I've ever known. So, the question is, why do I deceive myself so often? The most straightforward answer is I'm also the most selfish person I've ever known. Self is never the solution: it's always the heart of the problem. Jesus showed us the cure for selfishness. The Bible says, "(Jesus emptied Himself. He) made Himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant." Obsession with self is the disease, and allowing God to fill us with His servant nature is the cure.

We are God's friend! You would never say to a best friend, "I love you, but I don't like you!" A best friend is someone who has seen you at your worst and still loves you & still "likes" being with you. Do any of us have any question that God has seen us at our worst? I fail a lot! But God's promise is: "There's nothing you can do to make Me not like you!"



GOD'S FRIEND

The prophet Isaiah calls Abraham a friend of God. (Isaiah 41:8) Good choice. A best friend has seen you at your worst and still likes you. Make God your closest friend. He created you, loves you, died for you, and knows you best."

I DIDN'T THINK GOD LIKED ME FOR THE FIRST 30 YEARS

For the first 30 years of my Christian life, I didn't think God liked me. Now, if God was an imperfect human, that would make sense. But He's not! Each of us makes decisions to like or dislike people based on their past or present actions. But imagine being completely aware of everything a person will ever do. No longer would your estimation be based upon individual events. Your picture of them would be complete. At that moment, if you like them, it would be because you see the entirety of their lives. That's exactly how God sees us. If you've ever believed God loved or liked you, He still does. Why? Because "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever." (Hebrews 13:8). God enjoys you! "How precious... are Your thoughts to me, O God! How great is the sum of them!" (Psalm 139:17)

"True" Tolerance

TOLERANCE & PATIENCE

Whenever I read chapter one of Romans, I'm usually appalled. My mind is filled with horror and dismay at the depravity of the sin described. By the time I read chapter two, verse one levels the playing field and lets me see into my own heart. The Bible says, "You may think you can condemn such people, but you are just as bad, and you have no excuse! When you say they are wicked and should be punished, you condemn yourself, for you who judge others do these very same things." God didn't want me to think of others when I read the first chapter. Romans 2:4 says, "Don't you see how wonderfully kind, tolerant, and patient God is with you?"

REALITY / UN-REALITY

During the time of Jesus, Samaritans were considered half-breeds and universally despised by both Jews and Romans. Being Jewish and from Galilee, Jesus had experienced racial prejudice firsthand. He understood the cruelty of discrimination. Consequently, when He was traveling from Judea back home to Galilee, Jesus made a conscious decision not to skirt the prejudice around Him and face it head-on. He deliberately went through Samaria. A direct route from Judea to Galilee was about 70 miles or a two-and-a-half-day walk. But, due to prejudice, many Jews were willing to journey about twice the distance on a hotter and more uncomfortable road rather than go through Samaria. Jesus cut through this narrow-minded bigotry, and many Samaritans from a village named Sychar believed in Him. (John 4:39) What Samaria is God asking you to go to?

I DON'T WANT TO BE TOLERANT

Tolerance is defined as "the ability or willingness to tolerate something. In particular, the existence of opinions or behavior that one does not necessarily agree with." If this is what it means to be tolerant, then NO, I don't want to be tolerant. I will instead commit to be much, much more. I will look into the eyes of those I disagree with on moral and spiritual issues and tell them I love them, even when I know their beliefs and lifestyles are detrimental to their good and contrary to God's best. I will endeavor not just to put up with but also to speak the truth in love to those who vehemently disagree with me, and I with them. This is how Jesus loves us. I must do no less to others.

MY BATTLE WITH PREJUDICE

Each of us has our journey when it comes to prejudice. Mine is different from most. I am 100% Sicilian. Sicily is a small island below Italy. My father was born there and came to America as an immigrant. Since he was a leader in the Italian community, I grew up surrounded by people from the old country. I'm sure you've seen movies about the Sicilian mafia and the arrogant bravado of some Italian men. Early in life, some of my experiences became a significant turnoff. This prejudice against Italians caused me to not just dismiss my own heritage but to look down upon others with that background. Every culture has deficiencies, but we are called to love and forgive. I have since repented of my bigotry, have embraced the beauty of my culture, and am now proud to call myself a Sicilian.

REALITY / UNREALITY

"Judge not, that you be not judged. For with the judgment you pronounce, you will be judged, and with the measure you use, it will be measured to you. Why do you see the speck that is in your brother's eye but do not notice the log that is in your own eye?"

A modern definition of the word "bigot" states that a bigot is "a person who is intolerant toward those holding different opinions..." That may strike closer to home than we'd like to admit. So, before we start throwing the word "bigot" around, we might consider that our judgment of other people's seeming bigotry may qualify us as equally bigoted. We may be the biggest bigots we know.

More Healed Than Hurt

MORE HEALED THAN HURT

Other people have hurt all of us. It takes great courage to forgive those who hurt us. It took me many years to forgive the father who hurt me. I can only accurately represent God if I am willing to be more healed than hurt. Like Jesus, Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. was more healed than hurt. If you and I profess to know Jesus, then like Him, we need to be more compassionate than critical, more courageous than cowardly, more hopeful than hopeless, more selfless than selfish, more lighthearted than heavy-hearted, more kind than careless, more peaceful than anxious, and more fearless then fearful. But the only way for any of these character qualities that personify the heart of God to be lived out in my own life is if I am continually dependent upon Jesus.

HEALED & WHOLE

Some people get healed but are still not whole. Jesus healed ten lepers, but only one got whole and returned to glorify and thank God (Luke 17:15-16). Ironically, he was a Samaritan: half-Jew and half-Gentile.



PSALM 103:2-5

"Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits, who forgives all your iniquity, who heals all your diseases, who redeems your life from the pit, who crowns you with steadfast love and mercy..."

PLAGUE OF PUBLIC SHAMING

We've all been hurt by others. But how we respond to hurt will define who we are. The Bible says, "...Mary was engaged to be married to Joseph. But, before the marriage took place, while she was still a virgin, she became pregnant through the power of the Holy Spirit. Joseph, to whom she was engaged, was a righteous man and did not want to disgrace her publicly, so he decided to break the engagement quietly." (Matthew 1:18-19, NLT) Is it any accident that the man God the Father chose to be the earthly father of Jesus did not want to shame his fiancé publicly, even though he mistakenly thought she had gotten pregnant by another man? Wouldn't our world be better if people today refused to shame those who publicly hurt them? Love covers—hate shames.

REALITY / UN-REALITY

The great battle today is in the Spirit realm, between the "Have's" and "Have Not's".

Between those who have received what Jesus has done for them and those who have not. Those who are more focused on what Christ's death accomplished for them than on the death others have tried to put on them. It's really between the blind and the sighted. Those blinded by their own hurt and wounding, and those healed by the blood of Jesus, and willing to forgive and live rather than resist the love of God and die.

LIES & RESPONSES

Life is all about our responses. At times, we will feel cheated, lied to, and taken advantage of. We can overreact or appropriately respond, retaliate, or evaluate at these pivotal moments that test us to our core. Partial truths, overreactions, and bitter responses have fueled much of the evil in the world. More often than not, these half-truths are complete lies that become the ammunition for revenge, which God says is in His court alone. The Bible says, "...if you bite and devour one another, watch out that you are not consumed by one another...." (Galatians 5:15, ESV). "Jesus, keep us from believing lies and responding poorly to life's challenges! May we be those who heal and not hurt."



PAIN'S PURPOSE

Past hurts often keep us from seeing our hidden worth. Our true value isn't found in the high points of our lives but rather hidden under the rubble of our most significant pain. Only time, heat, and pressure can produce the most beautiful diamond. (Galatians 5:15, ESV). "Jesus, keep us from believing lies and responding poorly to life's challenges! May we be those who heal and not hurt."

"...be kind to each other, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, just as God through Christ has forgiven you." (Ephesians 4:32, NLT) While being hurt by others is inevitable, Jesus compels us to follow His example in forgiving, saying that he who has been forgiven little loves little, but he who has been forgiven much loves much. (Luke 7:47)









Persecution Is Here

SCAN ME

"... WITH PERSECUTIONS"

Don't overlook the fine print of all that Jesus said in the gospels. In Mark 10, Jesus said "...there is no one who has left house or brothers or sisters or father or mother or wife or children or lands, for My sake and the gospel's, who shall not receive a hundredfold now in this time-houses and brothers and sisters and mothers and children and lands, with persecutions--and in the age to come, eternal life." (Mark 10: 29-30, NKJV) If you were reading this too quickly, you might overlook two words, "with persecutions," and think, "No big deal!" But, upon closer examination, a lack of mental and emotional preparedness for persecution may be the stumbling block that eventually takes you out of the game. Persecutions are coming for all of us. Prepare yourself!

REALITY / UNREALITY

In China, if your church isn't state sponsored, it might be closed down like one of the 1,500 churches destroyed or shut down since November of 2000.

GLOBAL PERSECUTION

Over the past 30 years, the global phenomenon of Christian persecution has grown alarmingly.

JOHN 15:18-19

"If the world hates you, remember that it hated Me first. The world would love you as one of its own if you belonged to it, but you are no longer part of the world. I chose you to come out of the world, so it hates you."



Persecution Is Coming

PEOPLE MAY HATE YOU

Have you ever verbally acknowledged the possibility that, eventually, people may hate you because you follow Jesus? Probably not. But Jesus precisely said that: "...all nations will hate you because you are my followers." (Matthew 10: 22, NLT) It may not be a comforting thought, but it's still true because Jesus said it. Are you preparing your heart to be hated? I didn't say, "Have you decided on a strategy of saying obnoxious things to provoke people to hate you?" You won't need to do something terrible or insensitive to get people to hate you because Jesus said, "All you have to do is just love Me a lot and represent Me well, and people will hate you." I'm not paranoid, but I keep my heart prepared not to let the hate in others smother the love in me.

REALITY / UNREALITY

- Globally, more than 360 million Christians suffer at least "high" levels of persecution and discrimination for their faith.
- In 1993, Christians faced high to extreme levels of persecution in 40 countries. This number has nearly doubled to 76 countries in 2023.
- Worldwide, 1 in 7 Christians now experience at least "high" levels of persecution or discrimination.

JESUS & PERSECUTION

- "Indeed, all who desire to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted."
 (2 Timothy 2:12)
- "Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness sake, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven." (Matthew 5:10)
- "But I say to you, Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you..." (Matthew 5:44)

1 PETER 4:12-14

"Beloved, do not be surprised at the fiery trial when it comes upon you to test you as though something strange is happening to you. But rejoice insofar as you share Christ's sufferings, that you may also rejoice and be glad when his glory is revealed. If you are insulted for the name of Christ, you are blessed because the Spirit of glory and of God rests upon you."

PSALM 102:25-27L

WHAT JESUS NEVER PRAYED

Jesus never prayed we wouldn't have challenges or that we wouldn't have to lay down our lives for Him. He instead prayed to His Father that He would keep us from the evil one. (John 17:15) Sometimes, our struggles on Earth are connected to the deception of believing lies. Yet, most of the time, they are merely the tribulations of Earth Jesus promised would come. So, don't pray that Jesus would stop the difficulties in your life. It's a waste of your time. Pray that God will give you the fortitude to stand strong in adversity. To be courageous during hardship and persevere when you feel like giving up. If you do, it will be more than worth it. Be of good cheer. Because Jesus overcame, so can you.

Unreality Is Doomed

REALITY / UNREALITY

If the only time we believe in God is when we can actually see what we are believing for, we'll spend our lives not knowing Him. Trusting God and learning to walk by faith is not one of many good options; it is the only way to have a personal relationship with our Creator. It's also one of the most extraordinary experiences in life. It's worth every painful uncertainty about the future, all the lonely nights waiting for God to move, and dashed disappointments we thought were our destiny. In the end, if we hold fast and believe the promises of God, it will all be more than worth it. Seeing is not believing. Believing to see is.

ENDLESS HOPE

Though somewhat overstated, don't live waiting for tomorrow to begin. Learn to live, hoping today will never end.

WHINING VS. WINNING

One day, I found myself complaining in my head that God once again required me to believe in something I didn't have. Ironically, it was even after a significant answer to prayer that was, frankly, a "Hail Mary pass." I was embarrassed to think that my attitude toward my faith walk had become more whining than winning, even though God has been faithful to me for many decades. It's an unbelieving tic I need to stop. So, I'm doubling down and listening more carefully to the words I say and the thoughts I dwell on. If they are not fueling faith and hope in me, then I reject them as the lies they are. The thief always comes to steal, kill, and destroy. We should not be ignorant of his devices.

TRUE SUCCESS

All of us want to succeed. The problem comes when we try to define what it looks like. We can't! Only God knows what real success is. As David Wilkerson wrote, "When God calls you to something, He is not always calling you to succeed; he's calling you to obey! The success of the calling is up to Him; the obedience is up to you."

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




